Yet, there are many living here in this community who have no way to travel unless they walk, bike, or rely on friends/neighbors to go anywhere. At the same time, there are many folks here who own a number of vehicles that are not used on a daily basis and some, not used for weeks or months. If you have a working vehicle you can spare, please let us know. The Church will gladly provide a donation form and insure you receive a proper IRS-approved 501 (c) (3) deduction for your donated vehicle. Thank you.
