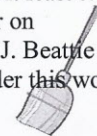
## FUNDRAISING DESSERT RECEPTION

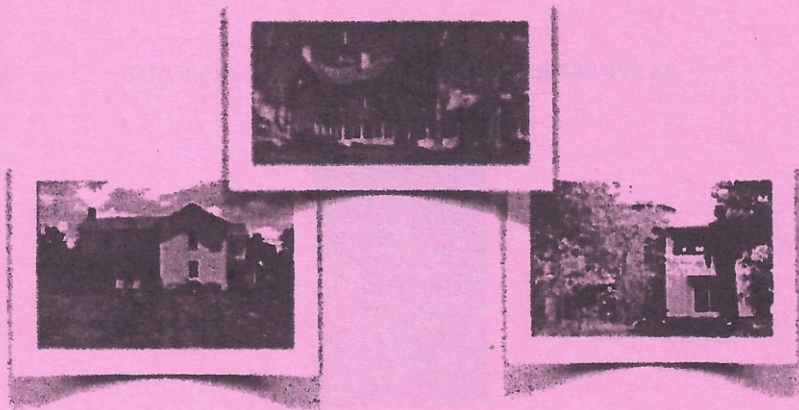
