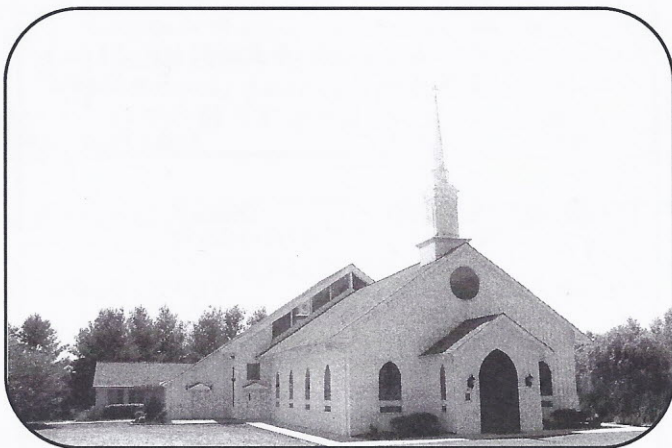

## FACT ABOUT THE MINIMUM WAGE AND THE PEOPLE WHO EARN IT

Nearly half (48.2%) of the 3 million hourly workers who were at or below the federal minimum in 2014 were ages 16-24. An additional 22.4% are ages 25 to 34, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics; both shares have stayed more or less constant over the past decade. The 3 million represents about 2.3% of all wage and salary workers.

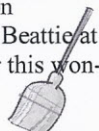
