

TIME TO REGISTER FOR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

St. Peter's has an EXCELLENT religious education program from age 3 right up through High School. HOW DO YOU LIKE THE PARKING LOT?

We are finished paving and stripping the parking lot. As you can see, we have moved the handicapped spaces nearer the front door of the Church. We have gained more parking. Now we have 63 spaces which will provide more than enough parking for the normal service of the Church. In the last heavy rain I checked the flow of water and the parking lot drains extremely well. The total cost of the job was \$85,000 (between two paving companies)

THE NEW PARISH SHED

Thanks to the assistance of Bob Ward and Bob Klaus, we have replaced the old rotten shed behind the church building with a new shed with the same dimensions (8' by 10') of the old shed. We placed the shed down the gravel path near the parish garden. In the shed we store the parish tools: the outside Nativity set; and the Holy Saturday and Holy Thursday equipment. The shed and installation cost \$3,548.00 The Knights of Columbus has contributed \$1,100.00 toward the cost of the shed.



DIRECTIONS TO THE VIGUERIE HOME

Coming from Little Washington

- Go East on 211 toward Warrenton.
- Turn RIGHT onto Route 729 at Ben Venue (about 6 minutes from Little Washington).
- After being on 729 for about 7 minutes you will come to a "T".
- Turn LEFT to stay on Route 729.
- After about 6 minutes you will see Route 615 on the right. Turn RIGHT on Route 615/Castleton Ford Rd.
- Go 7/10ths of a mile, looking to your RIGHT, see 3-acre POND and White House on a hill. Directly across from the mailbox is the gravel driveway leading you past the POND and up to the Viguerie home.

Coming from Warrenton

- Take Route 211 at Amissville (about 12 minutes from Warrenton) turn left onto Route 642.
- Follow Route 642 for about 5 minutes until you reach Route 640. Bear right on Route 640.
- Go 8/10ths of a mile and Route 640 will dead end into Route 729.
- Turn LEFT on 729 and go 2.4 miles until you reach Route 615, on the right, after about 5 minutes.
- Go 7/10ths of a mile, looking to your RIGHT, see 3-acre POND and White House on a hill. Directly across from the mailbox is the gravel driveway leading you past the POND and up to the Viguerie home.
