

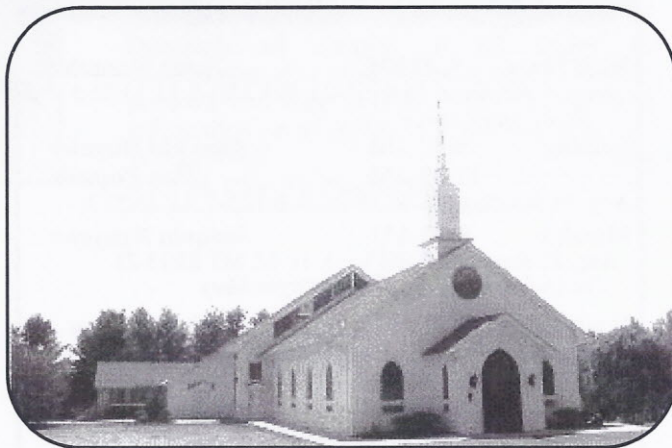

NOVENA FOR OUR NATION

Cardinal Burke endorsed a great initiative called the Novena for our Nation, a 54-day rosary prayer campaign which starts on the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary, and culminates with a rally in the nation's capital on the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7, (a date established because the Battle of Lepanto was won largely due to the Christians praying the rosary). You don't have to attend the rally in Washington DC to join the 54-day prayer novena. Simply pray the rosary (or at least a decade) every day for our nation, even though Aug. 15th has passed.

"The purpose of the **HOLY HOUR** is to encourage deep personal encounter with Christ. The holy and glorious God is constantly inviting us to come to Him, to hold converse with Him, to ask for such things as we need and to experience what a blessing there is in fellowship with Him." (Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen)

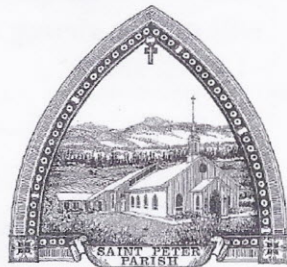

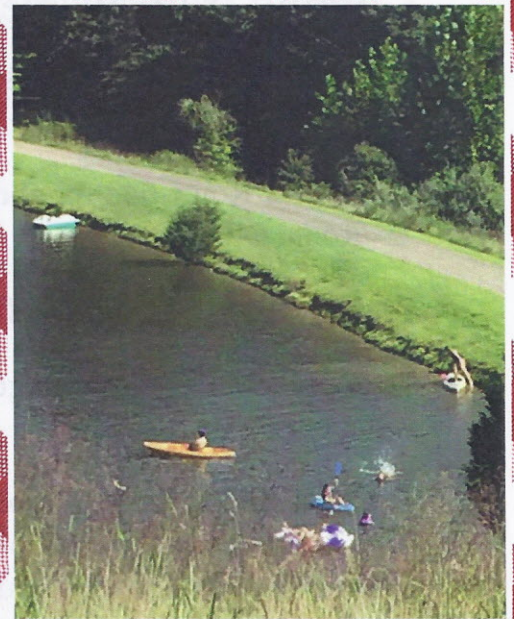

DIRECTIONS TO THE VIGUERIE HOME

Coming from Little Washington

- Go East on 211 toward Warrenton.
- Turn RIGHT onto Route 729 at Ben Venue (about 6 minutes from Little Washington).
- After being on 729 for about 7 minutes you will come to a "T".
- Turn LEFT to stay on Route 729.
- After about 6 minutes you will see Route 615 on the right. Turn RIGHT on Route 615/Castleton Ford Rd.
- Go 7/10ths of a mile, looking to your RIGHT, see 3-acre POND and White House on a hill. Directly across from the mailbox is the gravel driveway leading you past the POND and up to the Viguerie home.

Coming from Warrenton

- Take Route 211 at Amisville (about 12 minutes from Warrenton) turn left onto Route 642.
- Follow Route 642 for about 5 minutes until you reach Route 640. Bear right on Route 640.
- Go 8/10ths of a mile and Route 640 will dead end into Route 729.
- Turn LEFT on 729 and go 2.4 miles until you reach Route 615, on the right, after about 5 minutes.
- Go 7/10ths of a mile, looking to your RIGHT, see 3-acre POND and White House on a hill. Directly across from the mailbox is the gravel driveway leading you past the POND and up to the Viguerie home.
