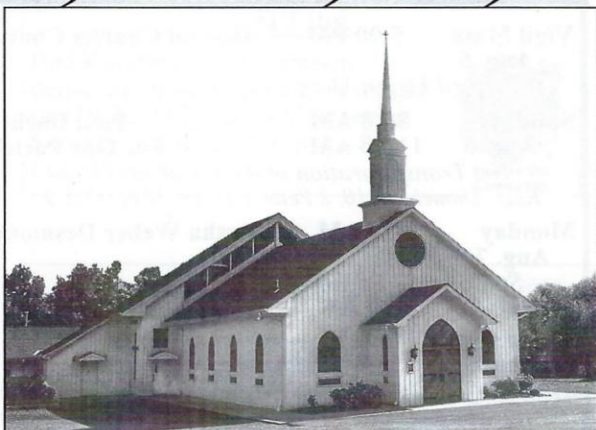

CELEBRATING FATIMA

100 years ago, a few days after Aug.13th, Our Lady appeared to the three children in Fatima and asked them to pray the rosary every day for peace, and to make sacrifices for sinners. On Sunday, right after the 11 am Mass on Aug.13, 2017, the Legion of Mary will hold a **Rosary Rally** at the entrance to St. Peter's driveway. Join us in our prayers for peace and for sinners.

Aug. 13th--On the 13th of each month, May through October, Pope Francis has granted a plenary indulgence opportunity for **100 anniversary of the Fatima apparitions..** To obtain the indulgence, visit with devotion the statue of Our Lady of Fatima, which will be near the altar in St. Peter's, and pray in honor of the Virgin Mary. Those seeking an indulgence must also pray an our Father, recite the Creed and invoke Our Lady of Fatima. The faithful must also fulfill the ordinary conditions to obtain a plenary indulgence: go to Confession and Holy Communion, be interiorly detached from sin, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father.

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints.
