REGISTER NOW FOR RE CLASSES!

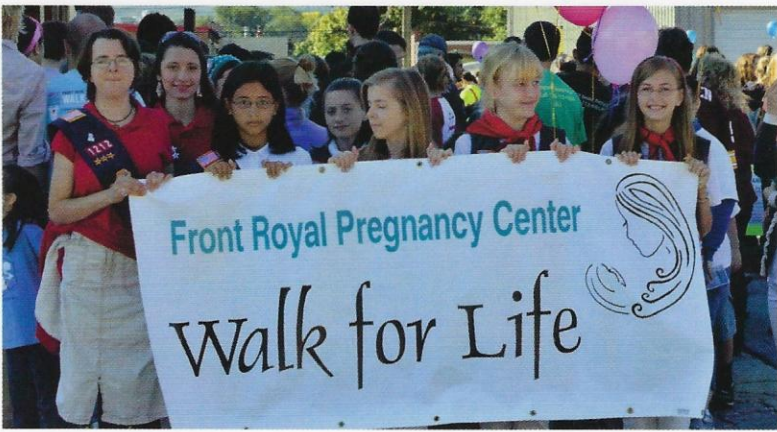
