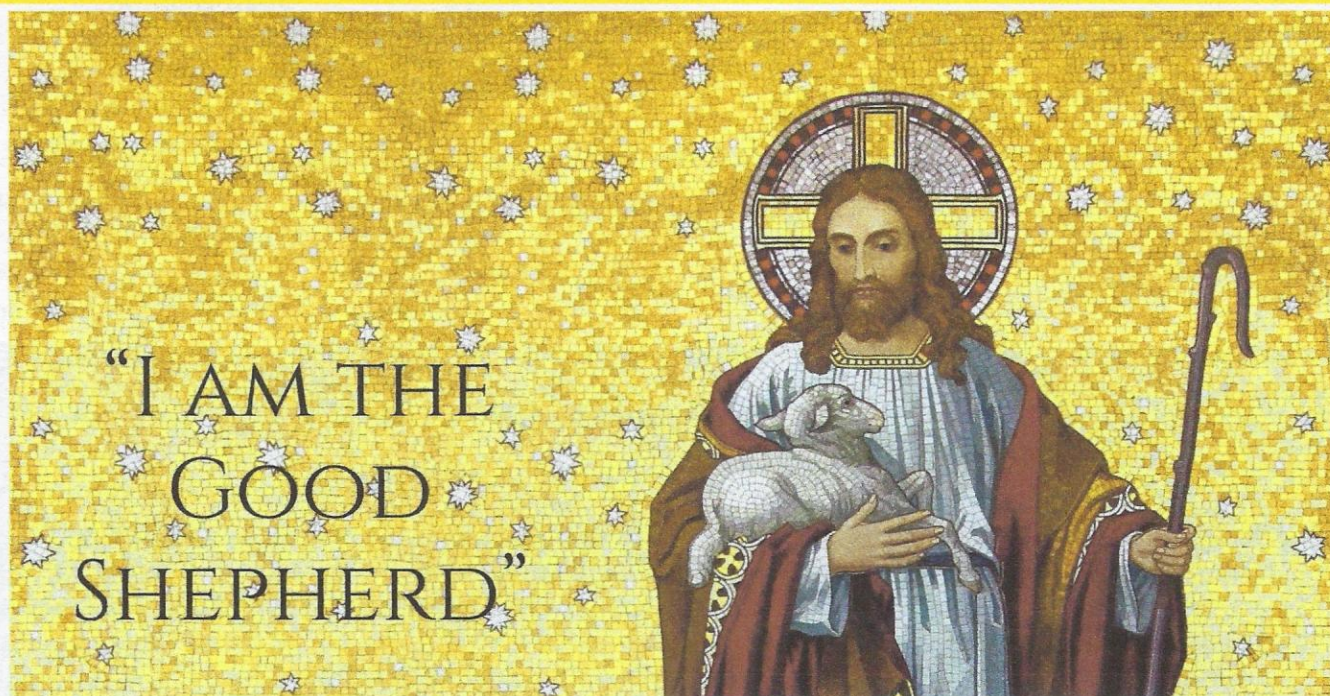

Harold Beebout of the Sperryville Rescue Squad will talk about strokes and "What happens when you call 911". **Beebout wants people to know how important it is to call 911 when someone may be having a stroke.** He's seen situations where the failure to recognize signs of a stroke and to call 911 have resulted in potentially preventable death and disability. He will discuss stroke symptoms and how to recognize a possible stroke in others. He will also discuss what happens when you calls 911; what procedures are performed in a rescue vehicle; and which hospital an individual can be transported to.

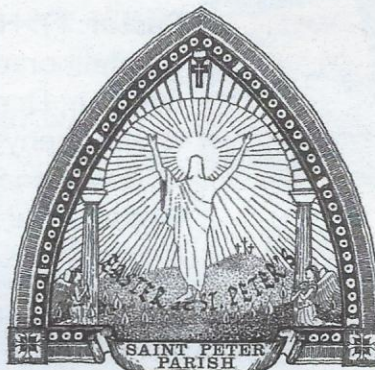

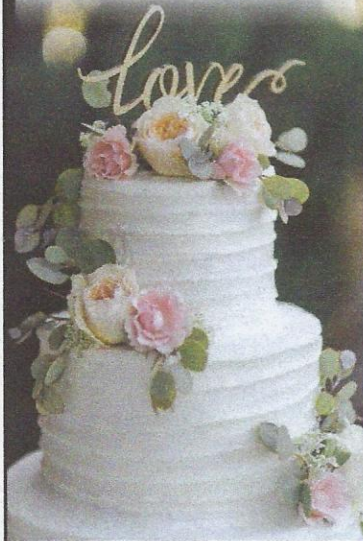
